As many of you know SIPAT has generously funded us to do a training with PLAYWORKS in an effort to encourage safe, meaningful play and physical activity at our school. The core values of PLAYWORKS are healthy play, inclusion, respect and healthy community.

With 12 hours of training under our belts we are excited to start rolling out this program at recess in the weeks ahead. To jump start the program we will begin with having parent supported PLAYWORKS activities a few days a week during lunch recess. Each week we will feature one game as our GAME OF THE WEEK. All of the games are chosen to be simple to learn, with only a few rules and very clear directions. Any conflicts (in/out, ties, etc) are solved using RO-SHAM-BOW to encourage very neutral conflict resolution. The games are OPTIONAL and regular recess activities can still be played while Playworks is in effect.

This week's game of the week is SWITCH - so be sure to ask your student if they got a chance to play!
