

ANNOUNCING THE PSAT/NMSQT

(Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test)

WHAT: The PSAT/NMSQT is a multiple-choice test measuring verbal and mathematical abilities shown to be related to success in college work. It is a shortened form of the SAT, which is required for admission to many colleges. This practice test will give you a preview of SAT and the scores will help you forecast future performance on the SAT. Scores on the PSAT/NMSQT may also qualify you for scholarship competition in the National Merit Scholarship Program.

NOTE: The PSAT/NMSQT must be taken in the junior year to qualify for National Merit scholarship consideration. If you took the test as a sophomore and did well, consider taking it again to get junior NMSQT selection score.

WHEN: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2008 from 8:00 A.M. until approximately 11:00 A.M.

WHERE: The test will be administered in the N & P -wings at Davis Senior High School.

COST: A fee of \$20.00 will be charged to take the test. (Make check payable to Davis Senior High School)

HOW TO REGISTER: Sign up at lunch at the Career Center Tuesday, October 7th through Friday, October 10th and pay your fee. NO REFUNDS. You will receive a STUDENT BULLETIN, which contains further information concerning college choices, preparing to take the test, eligibility requirements for the National Merit Program, etc. Sample test questions are also included in the Student Bulletin.

NOTE: Registration priority will be given to Juniors, Tuesday through Thursday, October 7-9. Sophomores may register for any available tests on October 10th.
