

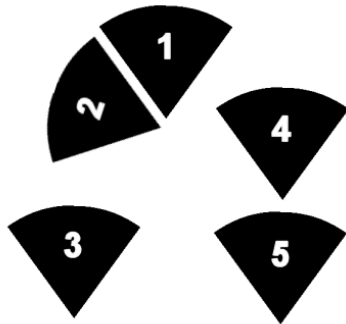


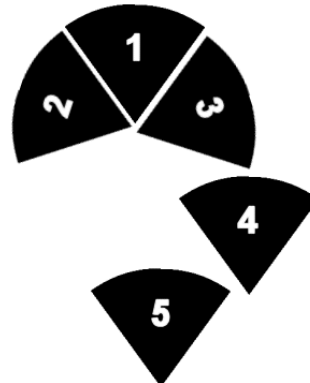
Making a Simple Mandala in Paint Shop Pro 7.02

1.	<p>A. Open a new image window, 500 x 500 pixels, transparent background. B. Open the image you are going to use. Right Click>Copy to copy it. C. Click on the transparent work Area, Right Click>Paste as New Layer</p>
Making the Mask	
2.	<p>A. Go to Selections...Load from Disk to get the Pie template. B. Navigate to the five-pie file in the your student account. C. Click on it to highlight it. Click Open. D. Now you should see the blinking outline of the pie template on your image</p>
Selecting the Imagery for the Mandala	
3.	<p>A. Right click>Drag to move the pie template into a good position. B. Go to Selections...Invert. C. Click Delete. D. Ctrl-D to deselect and remove the blinking outline. E. Left Click>Drag the pie template into position so other slices can be added</p>
Creating the Second Part of the Mask	
4.	<p>A. Right Click>Copy on the top blue bar. B. Right Click>Paste as New Layer to create the second pie slice. C. Go to Image>Mirror to mirror the pie. D. Move the second layer into the correct position. E. Go to Layers>Merge>Merge Visible.</p>
Copying the Pieces	
5.	<p>A. Right Click>Copy on the top blue tool bar of the image. B. Right click>Paste as New Layer. C. Repeat Right click>paste three more times for total of five pie slices</p>
Rotating and Assembling the Pieces	
6.	<p>A. Move two of the new pieces to the left and two to the right, as shown.</p>  <p>B. Go to Image>Rotate, Left, Free, 72. Click OK.</p> 

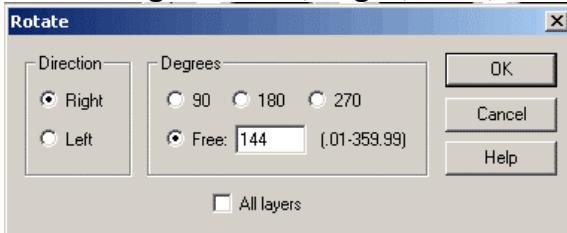
7. C. Move the rotated piece into position



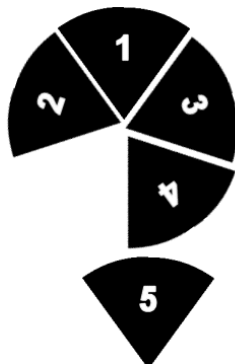
D. Left click **piece 3** to select it.
Go to **Image>Rotate**, and **change the direction to Right**. Click **OK**.
Move the rotated piece into position



8. E. Click on **piece 4**.
Go to **Image>Rotate, Right, Free, 144**



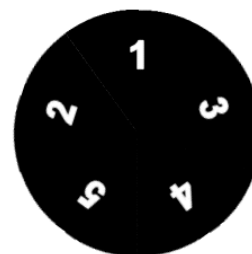
Click **OK**
Move into position



F. Click on **piece 5**
Go to **Image>Rotate, left, Free, 144**
Move into position



G. Once all the pieces are rotated and positioned, do final adjustments.



H. Go to **Layers>Merge>Merge visible**

Making the Outside Border	
9.	A. Go to Layers>New Raster Layer. B. Left click on Selection Tool Icon C. Right click on Selection Tool Icon , and go to Tool Options . Select circle D. Put the cursor right in the middle of the mandala E. Left Click>Drag to pull a circle out beyond the edge of the mandala.
10.	A. Click on the Flood Fill Icon B. Select a color from the Color Palette. C. Left click to put color into the circle. D. Ctrl-D to deselect the circle and remove the blinking outline. E. Go to Layers>Arrange>Send to Bottom. F. Go to Layers>Merge>Merge Visible
Making the Background	
11.	A. Go to Layers>New Raster Layer. B. Click on the Flood Fill Icon Select a color from the Color Palette. C. Left click to put color onto the mandala. D. Go to Layers>Arrange>Send to Bottom. E. Go to Layers>Merge>Merge Visible.
