The topic is, "What improvements can our school and district make to meet the needs of an English Learner." In the District school folks will get invited to listen to their speeches.</p> <p><b>Kellie Sequeira:</b> Birch Lane Intervention continues, she is determined to keep supporting reclassifying EL students through June. ELAC meeting was completed; preparation for the reclassification ceremony invitation had been sent and posted. The final week she will meet with 4th, 5th and 6th grade parents to give them ideas and support to keep students connected to learning during the summer.</p> <p><b>Ann Haines:</b> CCE is finishing ELPAC testing. It has been a great learning experience this year. Parents have been very supportive. Ann will be taking a writing course this summer to help 4th, 5th graders students. Looking forward to the reclassification ceremony.</p> <p><b>Michelle Secret:</b> At MME last month, 22 students were reclassified. Some of our 2nd and 3rd graders will end the school year learning Baile Folklorico representing 6 different regions from Mexico.
