



DJUSD Bond Project at Your Neighborhood School

Dear Neighbor,

The first series of projects funded by the Davis Joint Unified School District (DJUSD) Bond Program will include the construction of new science labs at the Emerson/Da Vinci Junior High campus. Each classroom will be 1,440 square feet and will include eight dedicated lab stations as well as flexible furniture to support lecture and small group instruction. In addition to the new science labs, two dedicated science preparation rooms and student/staff restrooms will be provided. Project completion is anticipated in Spring 2021.
