

Yolo County School Decision Tree: COVID-positive person on K-12 campus

Was the COVID-positive person within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes over a 24-hour period?

*PCR or rapid antigen testing are acceptable testing methods.
 † Persons who have been infected with COVID in the last 90 days do not need to quarantine or test after an exposure.

Is the exposed person vaccinated?

Exclude from campus. Test*† for COVID. If positive, isolate for 10 days and until symptoms improved and no fever for 24 hours. If negative, may return after symptoms improved and 24 hours without fever.

Is the exposed student vaccinated?

May continue in-person. Test*† for COVID 3-5 days after exposure.

Were both + person and exposed student wearing masks during exposure?

May remain on campus. Monitor for symptoms. Test*† for COVID 3-5 days after exposure.

Exclude from campus for 10-day quarantine.† Test*† for COVID 3-5 days after exposure. May shorten quarantine† to 7 days if negative test* collected on Day 6 or later post-exposure.

If testing available, may continue in-person on 7-day modified quarantine. Test*† 2x/week for 7 days after exposure. No sports or extracurricular activities permitted. May end modified quarantine† after 7 days if negative test* collected on Day 6 or later post-exposure. If testing not available, exclude from campus for 10-day quarantine.†

Exclude from campus for 10-day quarantine† if untested. May shorten quarantine† to 7 days if negative test* collected on Day 6 or later post-exposure.
